GOOD REASONS TO VISIT

- The arched ceiling of the grand staircase and its grotesque decor.
- The conservatory of ancient grape varieties.

Built in the 16th century, this château in the Bourbonnais region has a sculpted interior decoration characteristic of the second French Renaissance.

All the rooms are decorated with murals from 1560-1570 taking inspiration from classical art. They depict mythological and astronomical themes. Outside of the château, the tour continues freely in the repository of ancient vines from Chareil and Saint-Pourçain vineyards.

DID YOU KNOW...?

The château once belonged to Claude Morin, '*contrôleur ordinaire des guerres*', a position tasked with reviewing the troops, in around 1550.
